- University of Greenwich

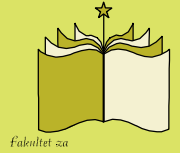
Most professors are at the same time the experts who work at or for the institutions of the European Union and other international organizations and institutions.

The Faculty of Administrative and European Studies was founded as an institution of the higher education. It was registered within the Central Register of the Economic Court in Podgorica on May 9, 2005. The founders are the Municipality of Podgorica, the Faculty of Postgraduate Administrative and European Studies from Kranj (Slovenia), a domestic NGO – the Agency for Local Democracy and Partnership of Montenegro and two physical persons from Italy and Slovenia.

On 29th March 2006 the Higher Education Council of the Republic of Montenegro gave the Accreditation to this institution and its three study programs (the undergraduate, the Master in Administrative Studies and the Master in European Studies). The Ministry of Education and Science issued the license to the Faculty on May 24, 2006.
